TOWN MEETING MINUTES Tuesday, June 4, 2024 7:00 p.m.

### I. CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Troy Bivens called the meeting to order and opened the meeting with prayer. Mayor Bivens initiated the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

#### II. APPROVAL OF MINUTES
