# TOWN MEETING MINUTES Tuesday, June 3, 2025 7:00 p.m.

#### I. CALL TO ORDER

Councilman Cox opened the meeting with prayer. Mayor Bivens initiated the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

#### II. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Councilman Cox motioned to approve the May 6, 2025 minutes. Councilwoman McCombs seconded the motion.

### V. OPEN PUBLIC FORUM (Town Citizens can speak up to 3 minutes)

Celia Pauline with Brisk MD informed Council of the Grand Opening on June 7th at the Gaston Pharmacy location and in the park beside Town Hall.

Councilwoman McCombs motioned to close the public forum. Councilman Cox seconded the motion.

# VII. OPENING STATEMENT (Information from Mayor and Council)

- Agendas and sign up sheets were located at the front door.
- Sherry presented the financial update review for March, 2025 and April, 2025
- Councilwoman McCombs motioned to accept the 2<sup>nd</sup> reading of annexation property located at Hunter Wood Drive, Lot 8 (TMS# 010000-02-400). Councilman Cox seconded the motion.

- Councilwoman McCombs motioned to accept the 2<sup>nd</sup> reading for rezoning property located at 1442 Mack Street from R-2 (Rural Residential) to R-1 (Single Family Residential). Councilman Cox seconded the motion.
- Councilman Cook motioned to pay \$2000 for the cost of steel tables for the cooking area at the back of the kitchen. Councilman Sharpe seconded the motion.
- Bids for Lawn Care were reviewed. Councilman Cook motioned to accept the lawn care bid from Patriot Timber and Land in the amount of \$23,400 for the year. Councilwoman McCombs seconded the motion.
  - Bids for Cleaning were reviewed. Councilman Cox motioned to accept the cleaning bid from Jan Pro in the amount of \$800 per month. Councilman Sharpe seconded the motion.

### - Assignments for Council (Updates):

- Councilman Cook Steel tables and gate look good that were installed in the cooking area Outside the Kitchen. Cameras for Town Hall building are being worked on. Have a design idea for the new town sign along that would include a flag pole and Honorary Mayors and Council members plaque.
- Councilwoman McCombs Thanked Councilman Cook for visiting the new bakery. Gaston Library has the summer reading kick-off on Monday, June 9. Councilwoman McCombs asked if Council would donate \$350 to the Friends of the Library to help with the Library activities. Councilman Cook motioned to donate \$350. Councilman Sharpe seconded the motion.
- Councilman Sharpe Asked when the Town of Gaston was founded.
- Councilman Cox Wanted to make PD aware that someone is driving a 4-wheeler late at night disturbing the peace around Indiana Drive.
